(aged 10-12)

- Preferred the new F9 to the previous one.
- Much easier to understand.
- "It explains everything to me"
- Solicitor read it through with child and it made sense to her.
- Had not received any F9 from the court and said that had she received the initial letter from the court she would have understood what it meant without solicitor's assistance, though found it much easier to speak to solicitor about it and fill it in.
- She doesn't think she would have wanted to speak to her teacher about it to help her fill the form in, and there was nobody else she could think of that could have helped her. She felt that she needed help actually physically filling the form in and wanted solicitor to write " her words".
- "Gives me much more space to write things that I want"
- "It actually asks proper questions that I can answer rather than just ticky boxes"
- Particularly liked the faces and liked the questions that were asked.
- Client was surprised that he wasn't going to hear back from the court (at the moment anyway) regarding what the outcome of the court hearing was.
